What does a job cost sheet include. Cost sheet define. What is a job cost sheet and why is it useful. Job order cost sheet define.

Job cost sheet is a document used to record manufacturing costs and is prepared by companies that use job-order costing system to compute and allocate costs to products and services. The accounting department is responsible to record all manufacturing costs (direct materials, direct labor, and manufacturing overhead) on the job cost sheet. A separate job cost sheet is prepared for each individual job. All necessary details about the job and costs incurred to complete the job are written on the job cost sheet. The information about a job or order that is shown on job cost sheet usually includes job number, product name, starting date, completing date, number of units completed etc. The information about manufacturing costs that is shown on job cost sheet usually includes materials requisition number, cost of direct materials issued, time tickets, direct labor hours, direct labor rate per hour and total cost, manufacturing overhead rate per direct labor or machine hour and total cost etc. Job cost sheet is not only used to charge cost to jobs but is also a part of the company's accounting record. It is used as a subsidiary ledger to the work in process account because it contains all details about the job in process. Example: An example of a complete job cost sheet is given below: More from Job-order costing system (explanations): A job cost sheet generally refers to an accounting document that is used to calculate the costs of a particular project or order, commonly referred to as a job. Such a document can be developed manually, using spreadsheet software, or using software designed specifically for job costing. Calculating job cost can be very complex. For this reason, software which is designed specifically for that task has been developed. It can be run on a computer and will calculate the costs of a job. The accuracy of the information that is entered into the software is critical. If the information is not entered correctly, the results will be incorrect. The information that is entered into the software is usually entered individually. Hours worked at a normal rate per hour should be differentiated from hours that were worked at overtime. Generally, a total cost for labor per person is calculated. This can be useful in determining which departments were most cost intensive for the project. Eventually, a total cost of all labor will be calculated as well. The costs of materials are also included on a job cost sheet. These are generally itemized by product. Whether or not the partial use of an item is accounted for as a whole depends on a company's accounting practices. To be accurate, the job cost sheet needs to include sales tax, shipping costs, and overhead. When the costs of multiple jobs are being determined, it can be a difficult but necessary task to prevent the overhead cost from overlapping. Two of the final values on the sheet will be the total job cost and the profit. The profit can be determined by deducting the total job cost from the sales price. It is difficult to determine what a standard job cost sheet is. These documents can greatly vary from one company to another and from one job to another. This is because the costs can greatly vary. A project may, for example, need additional services such as consulting or outsourcing of some aspects of the job. These costs generally do not fit in any of the categories outlined above. These costs may be included in another category, such as services. Before a job is begins, there is generally an estimate of costs. These are usually categorized. A job cost sheet can be used to compare the categorized actual costs to the estimated costs. When there is a disparity, the results of the sheet can be used for future reference when quoting the rates of similar projects. Definition: A job cost sheet is a record of all expenses relating to a single job or job segment. Companies that use a job order cost accounting system try to segregate costs by job to see how much each product or job lot costs to make. In other words, they want to know what the unit price is per product produced. In order to figure out how much each unit costs, to produce, the company has to track the work that was done to each product before it was completed. What Does Job Cost Sheet Mean? This is where a job cost sheet comes into play. A job cost sheet is exactly what it sounds like. It's a record of the costs incurred for a single job. A job cost sheet usually includes the customer name, job number, date started, date completed, description of the job, and the estimated completion date. As soon as the project is completed, the job cost sheet is filed away. Next the sheet gets passed to the material department. The wood is carefully selected for the guitar and the costs are recorded on the job cost sheet. The production line gets the cost sheet next. They record the labor and other processes incurred to turn those pieces of wood into a guitar on the sheet. After everything is finished, a supervisor or foreman evaluates the guitar and the cost sheet and assigns an estimated overhead cost to the guitar. The supervisor then adds up the total costs, makes any notes or exceptions, and signs the job cost sheet. This completed job cost sheet can be given to management to compare with production estimates and revenues from product. Management can use job cost sheets not only to improve production efficiencies and cut costs, but they can also use these sheet to help estimate product sale prices.
